Home-School Agreement



This Home-School agreement is a statutory statement which explains Botley C of E Primary School's aims and the responsibilities we have towards your child. It also sets out the responsibilities of parents in supporting the school and your child to thrive.

The school will:

- care for your child's safety and happiness;
- ensure that your child is given opportunities to thrive in a range of academic and non-academic areas;
- value your child as a respected member of the school community;
- provide a balanced and varied curriculum to meet the individual needs of your child;
- ensure high standards of work and behaviour through the building of good relationships and developing the children's understanding of responsibility;
- be welcoming and open at all times and offer opportunities for parents to become involved in school life and their child's learning;
- contact parents if there are issues around attendance, behaviour, punctuality or uniform and address any concerns openly and honestly;
- keep parents updated on their child's progress and problems that may be affecting their work;
- provide opportunities for home learning;
- arrange parent's evenings across the year for you to discuss your child's progress, attitude, behaviour and social development with their teacher / teachers;
- keep parents informed about school activities and news through letters and the school website;
- make school policies accessible to parents that detail key information and procedures;
- provide parents with appropriate support and advice.

Parents will:

- ensure that their child always attends school (unless there is a justifiable reason), on time, wearing correct school uniform and properly equipped;
- notify us if their child is absent from school and provide a reason for this absence;
- inform us of any issues or problems that may impact on their child's work or behaviour;
- support our policies and guidelines for behaviour and attendance;
- support their child with home learning and other opportunities to learn outside of school;
- support their child to read and access books;
- raise any concerns they have about their child directly with us;
- not use social media in a way that impacts negatively on the school;
- attend parents' evenings and discussions about your child's progress;
- provide us with current contact details and ensure that they or another nominated adult are contactable at all times;
- provide the school with sufficient and up-to-date information about their child's medical needs;
- carry out any actions that they have agreed to as part of their child's individual healthcare plan if one is required;
- always treat staff in a polite and respectful manner.

Together, we will support your child's learning to help them achieve and succeed.
