

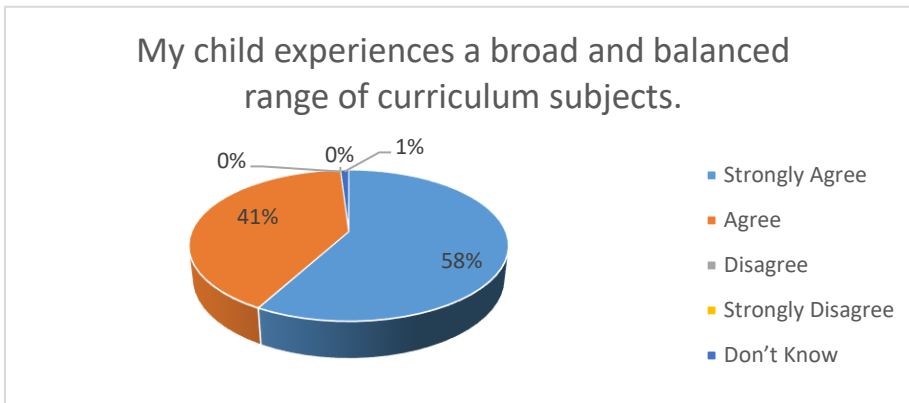

Please find below the outcomes of our recent parental survey.

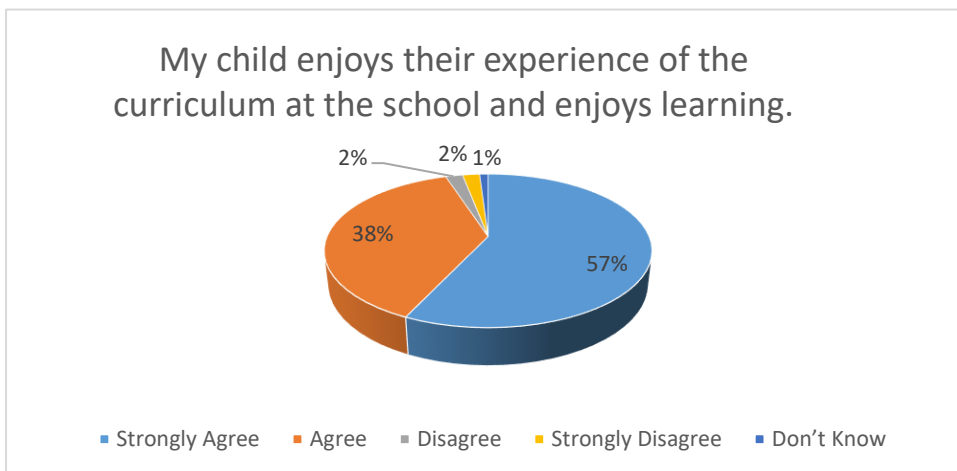
Thank you to all of those that participated as it gives us really helpful information about the school and enables us to identify any areas for development from the perspective of parents.

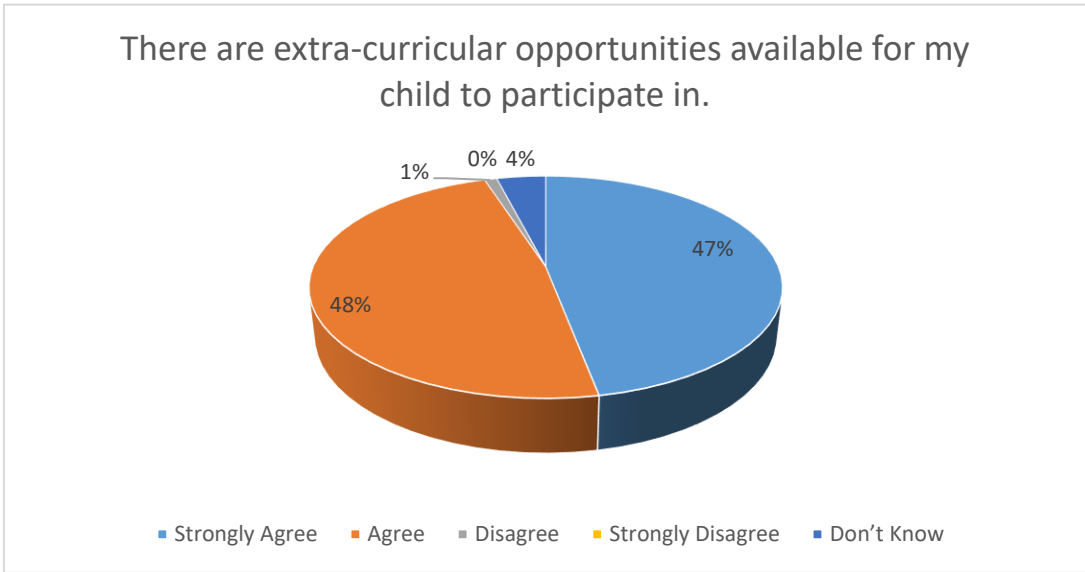

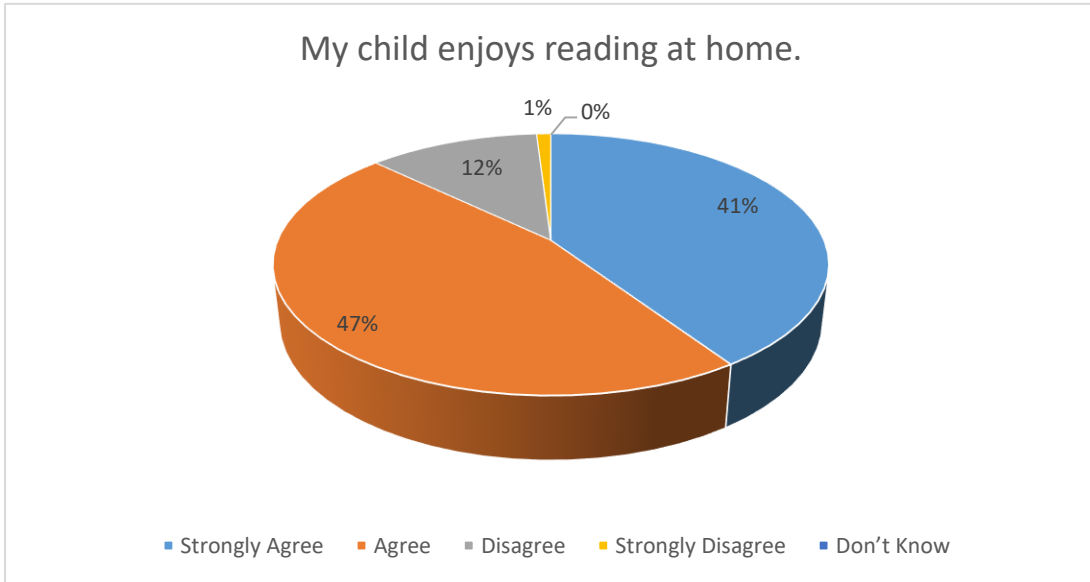

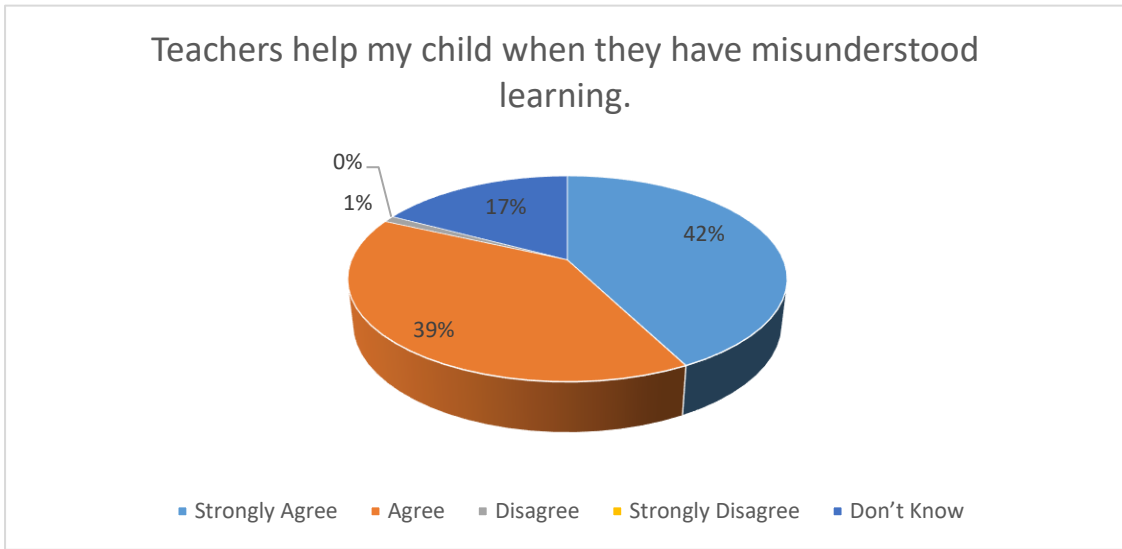

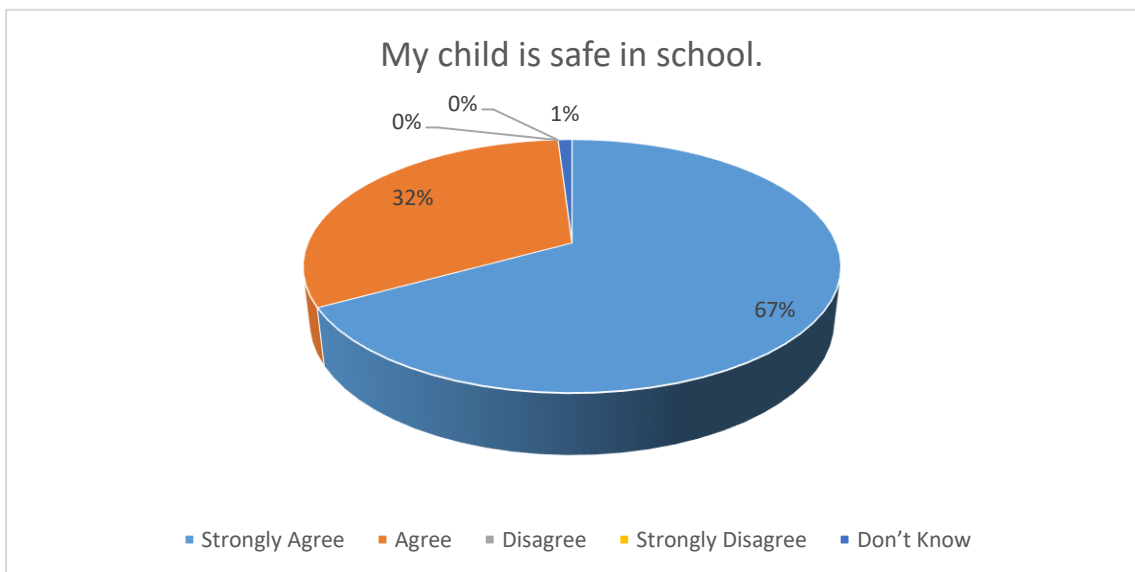

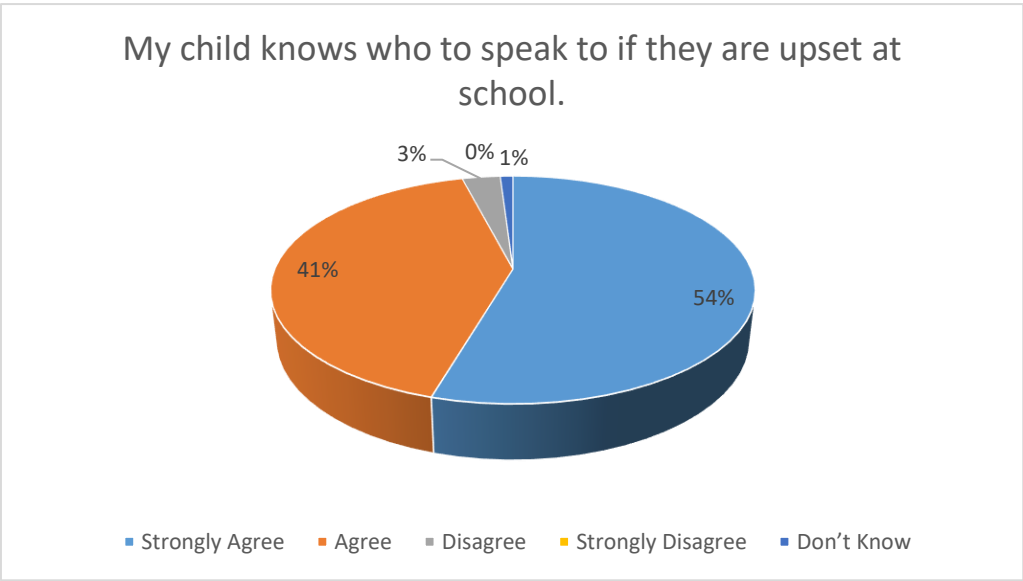

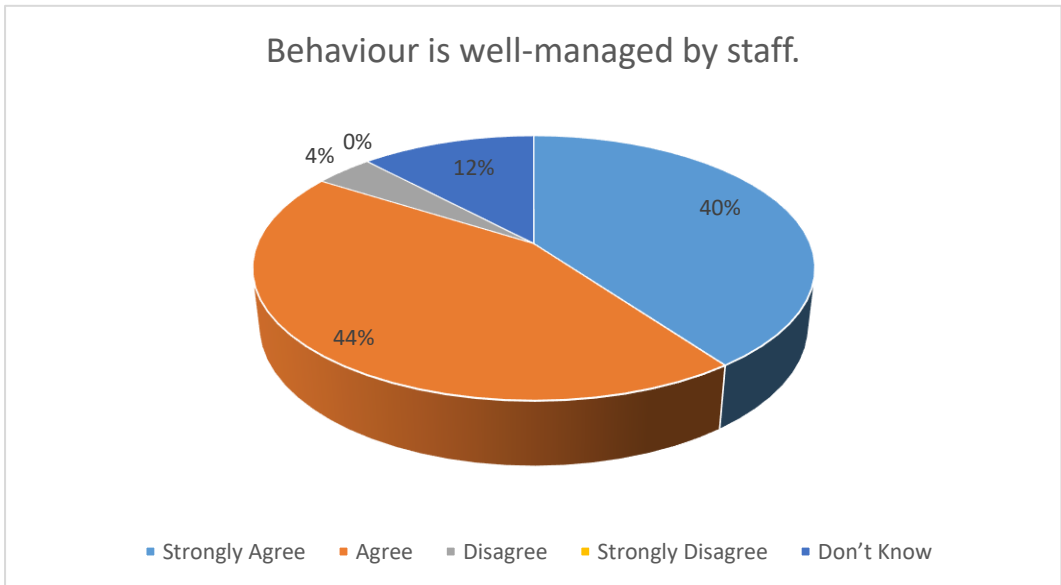

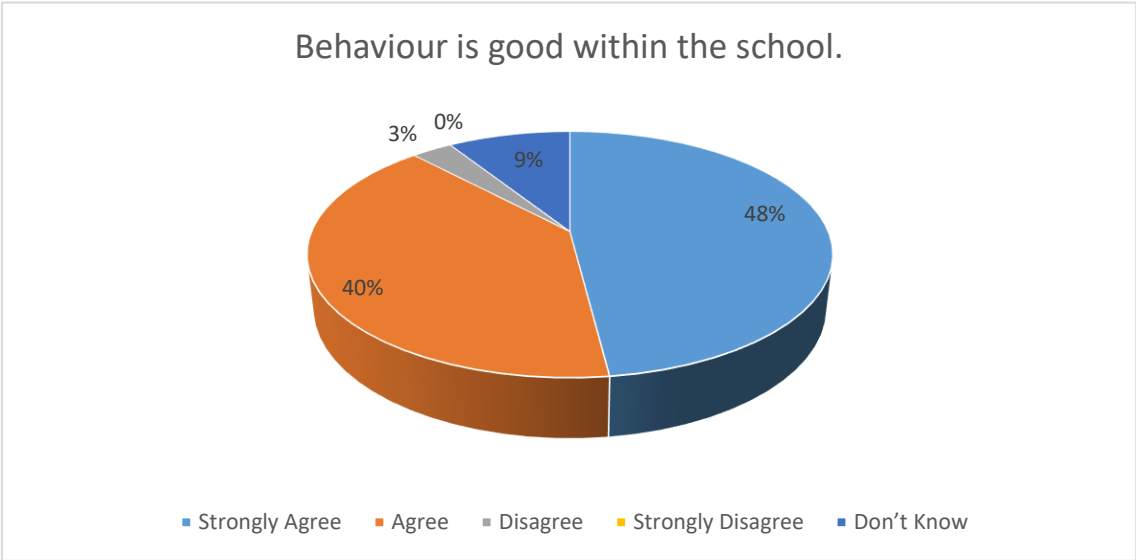

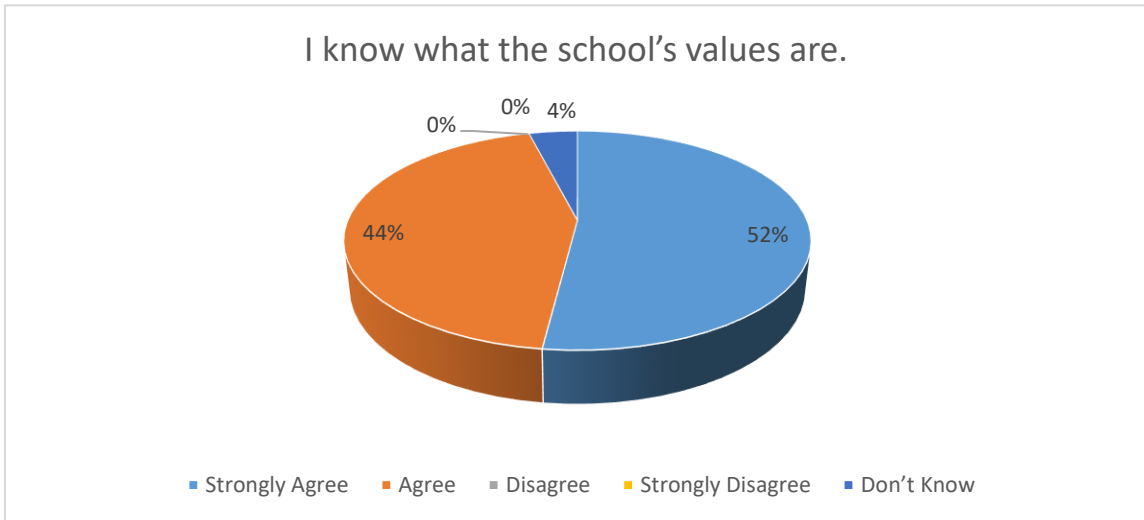

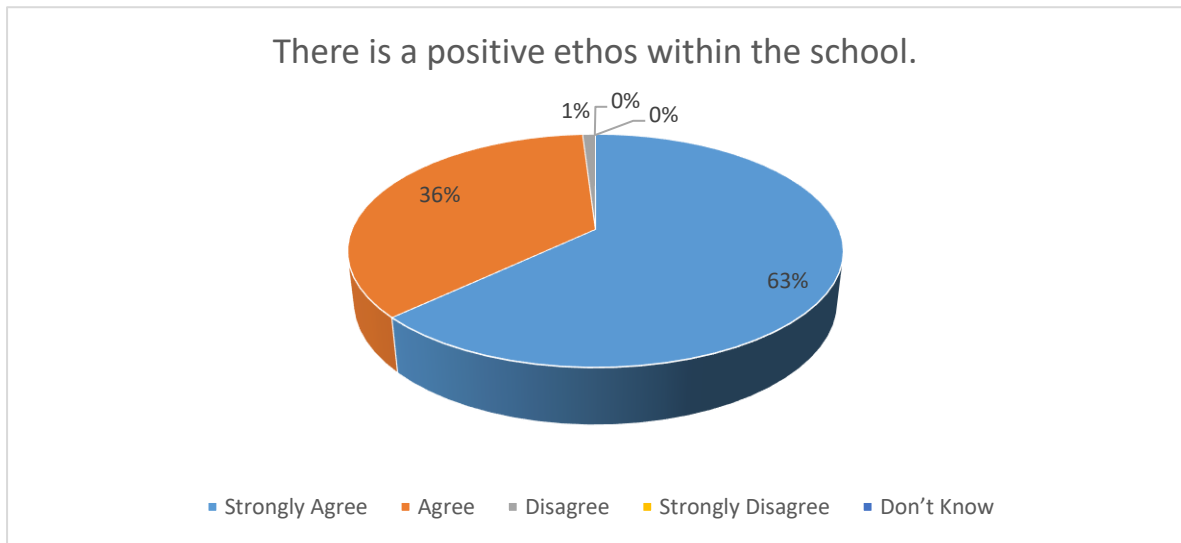

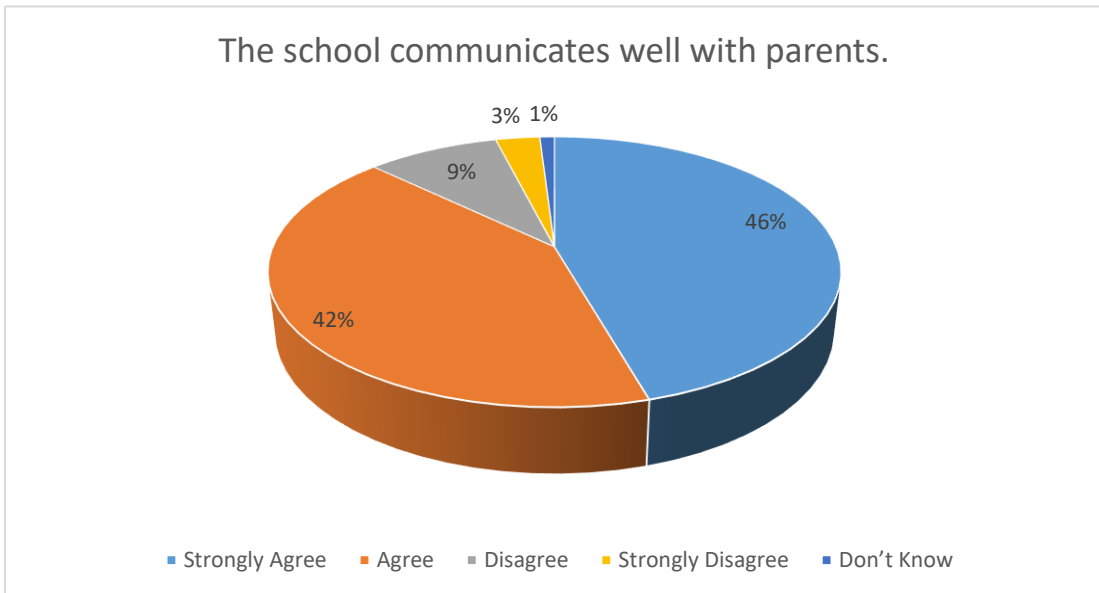

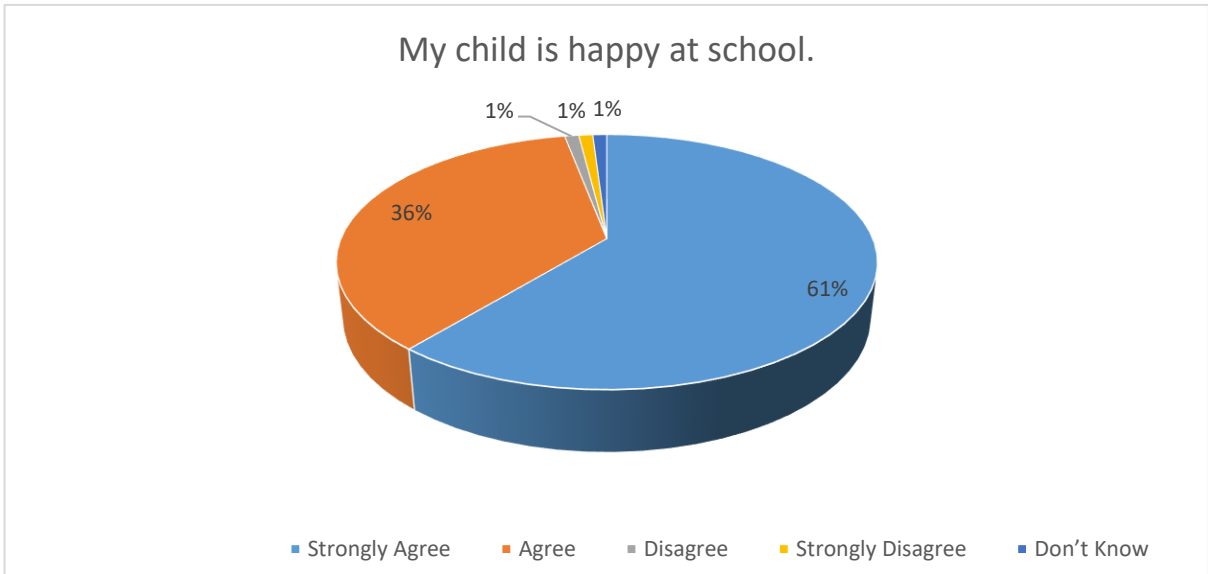

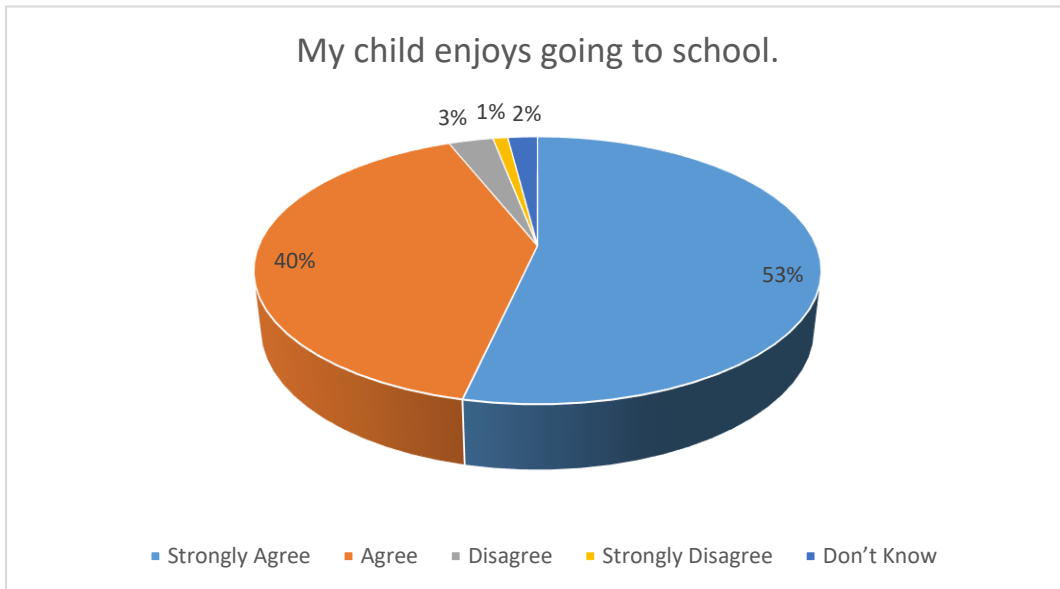

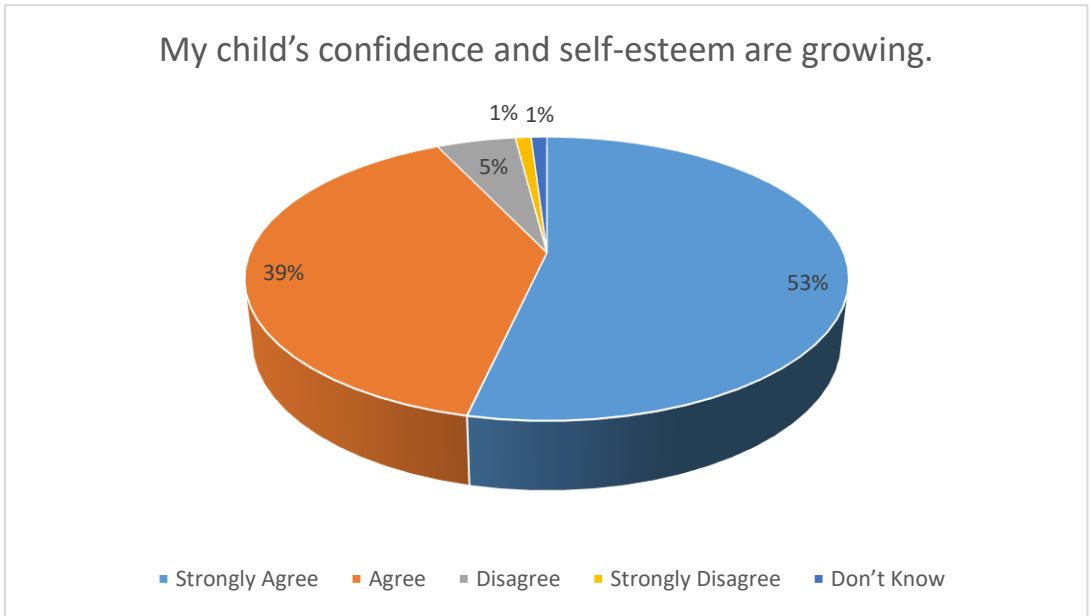

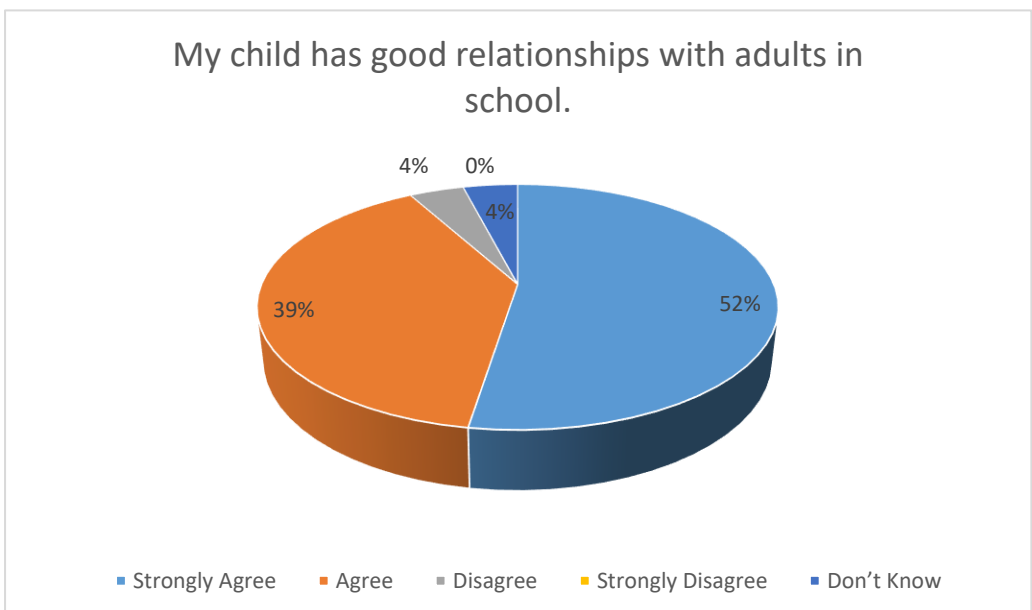

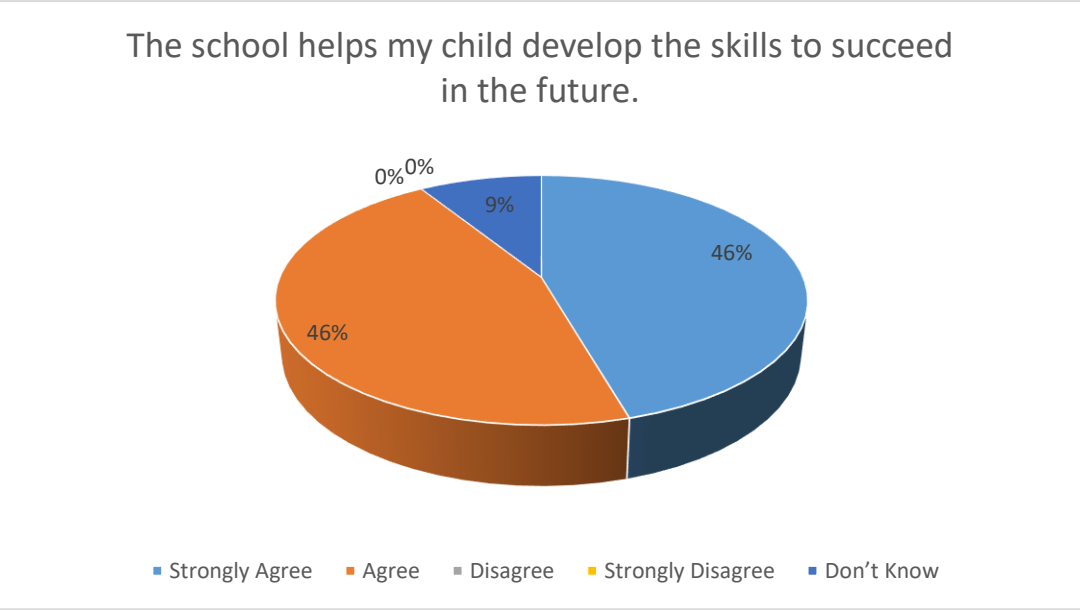

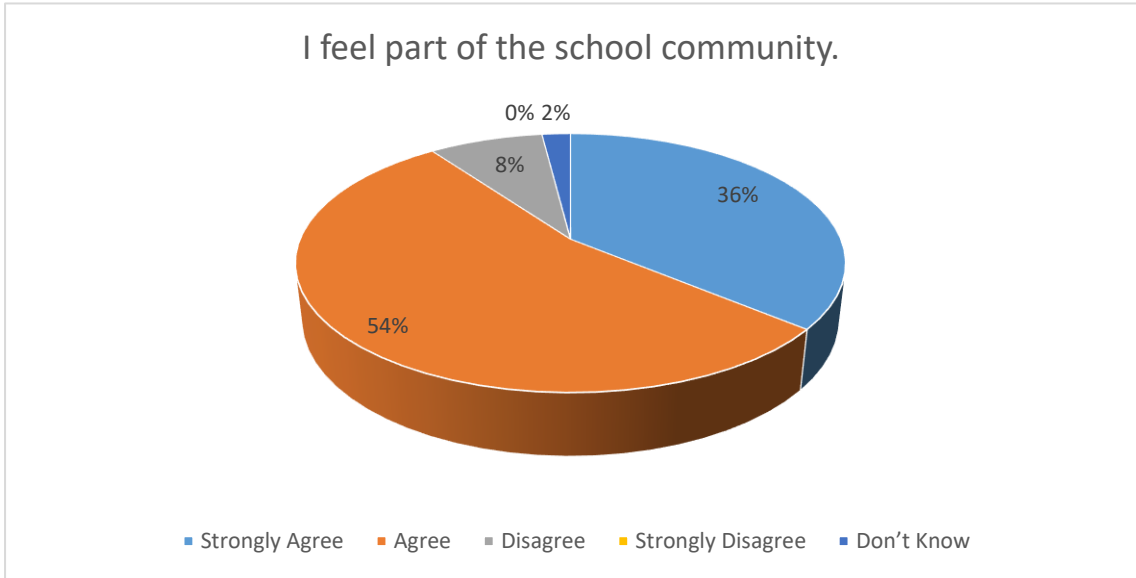

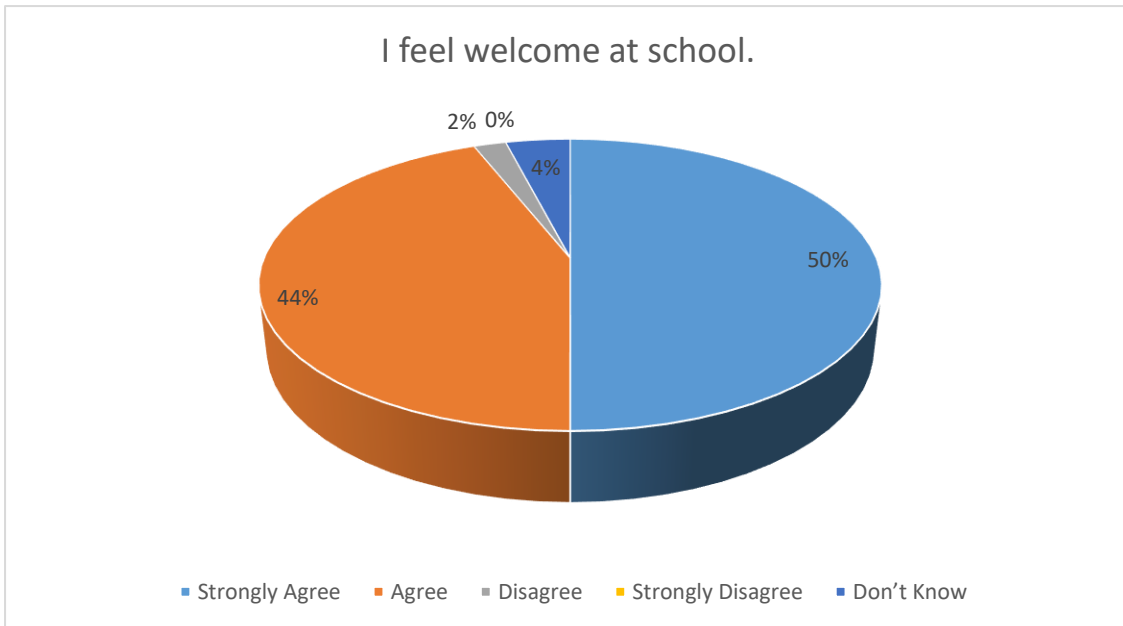

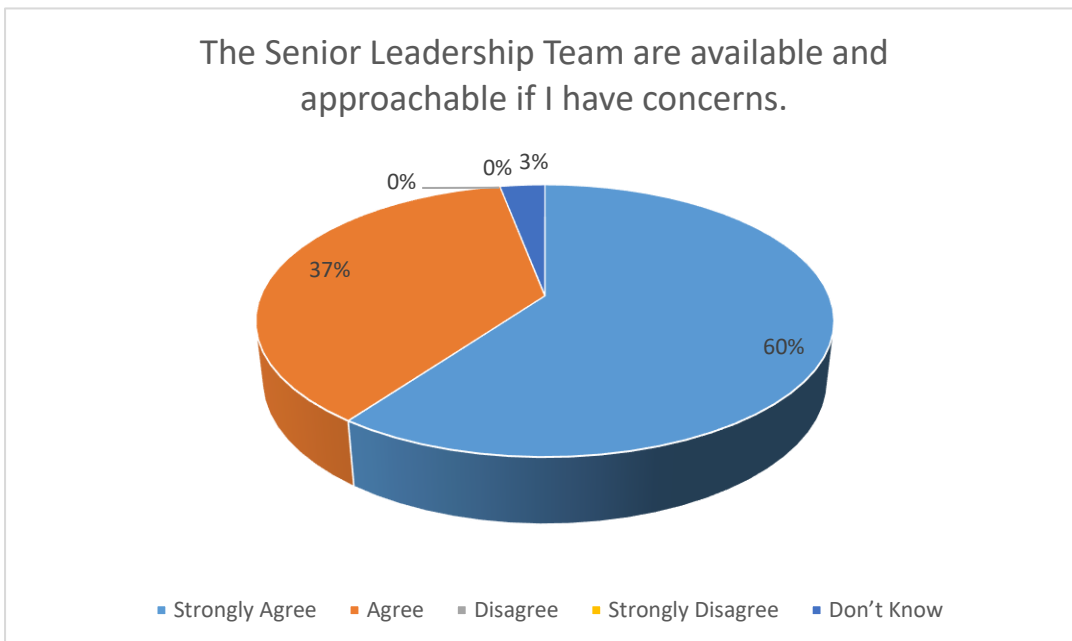

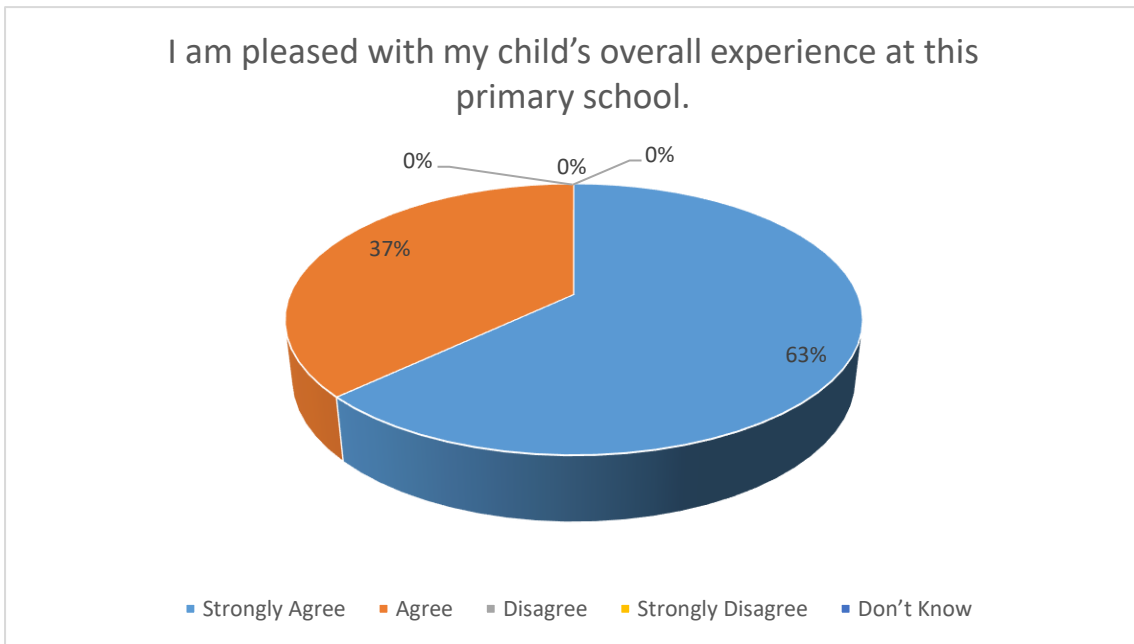

- Communication
- Too much / not enough focus on the Christian aspect of the school
