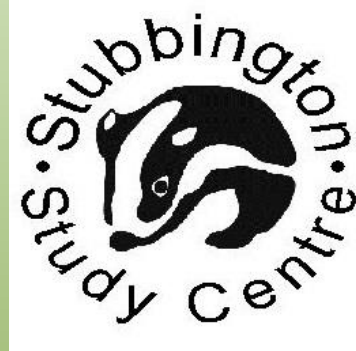

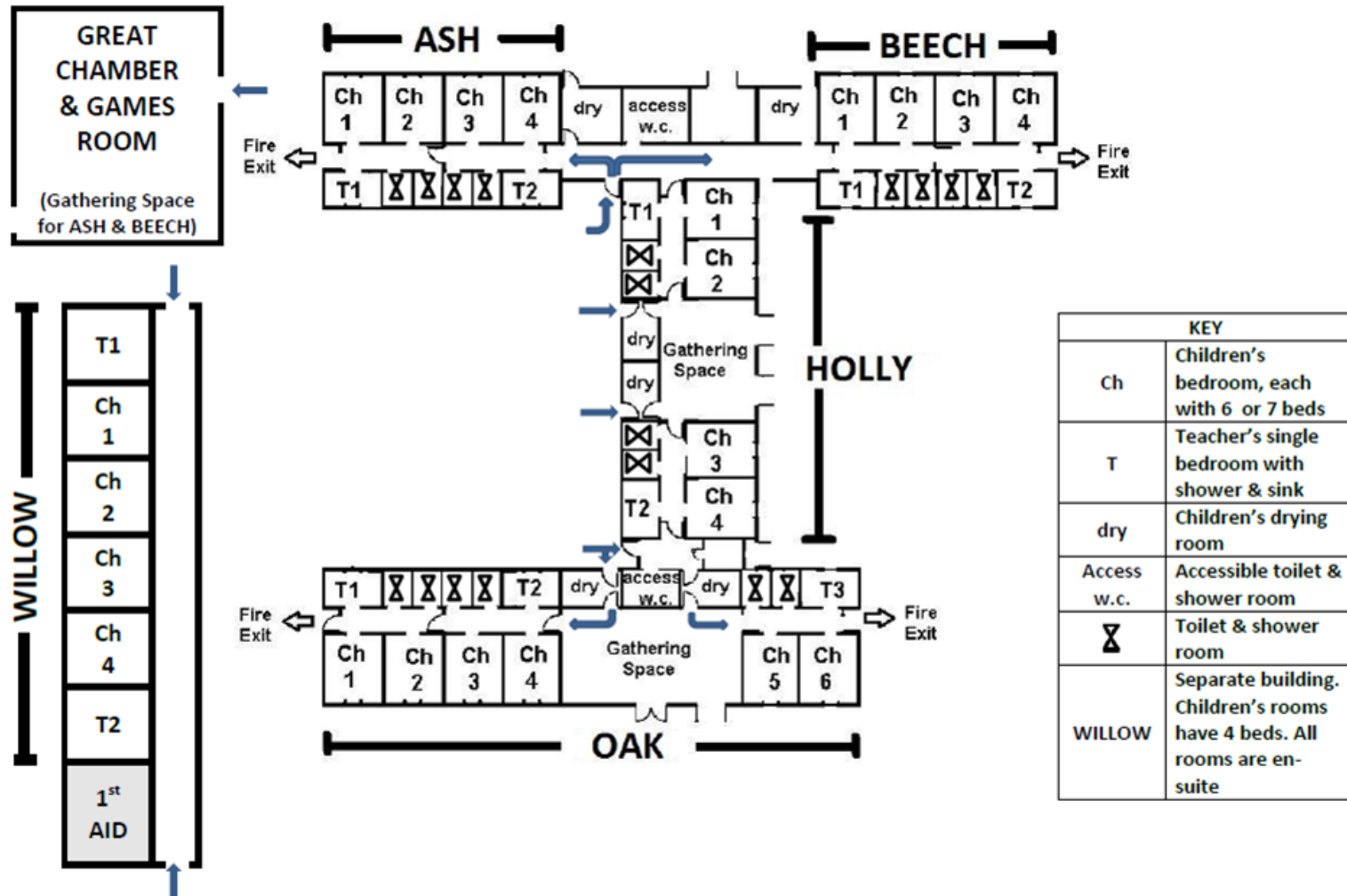
# Where are we?

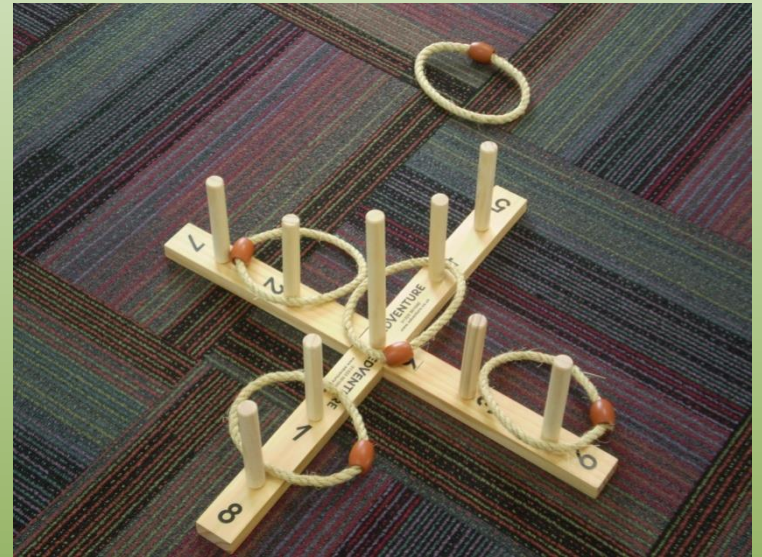
