

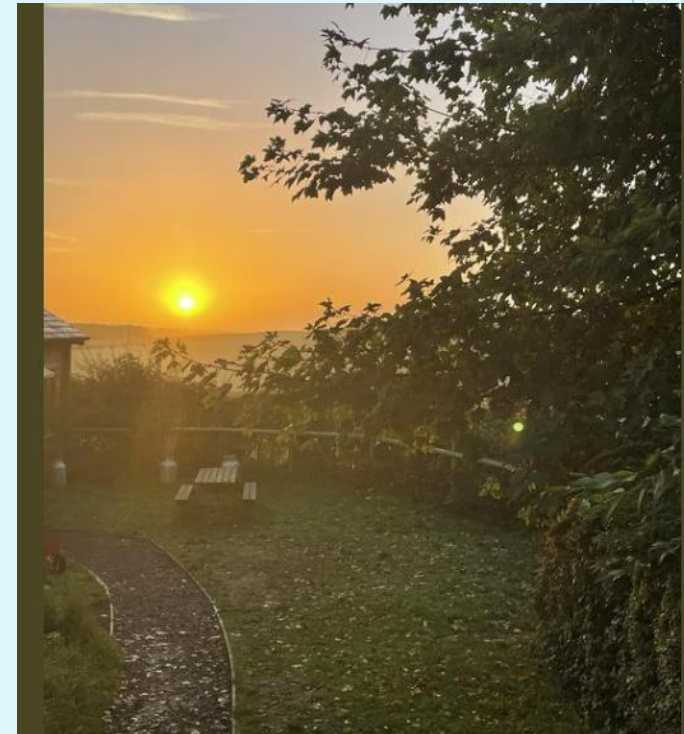
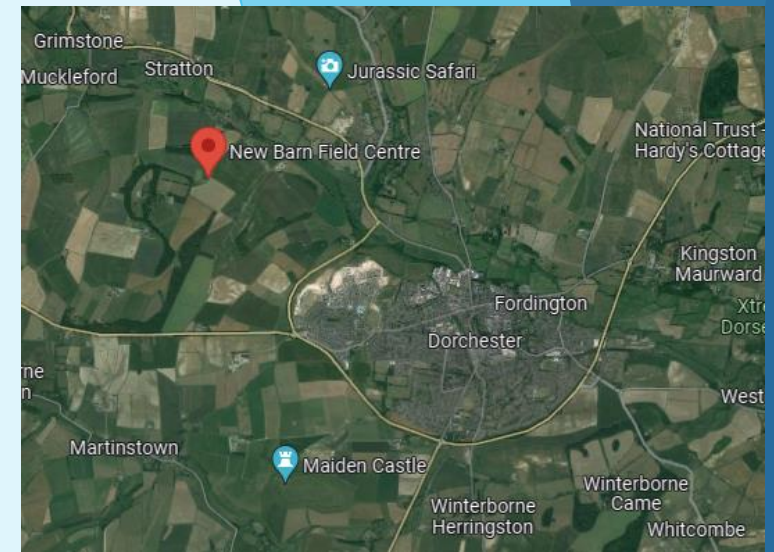


# Botley C of E Primary School

New Barn Residential 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> October 2024

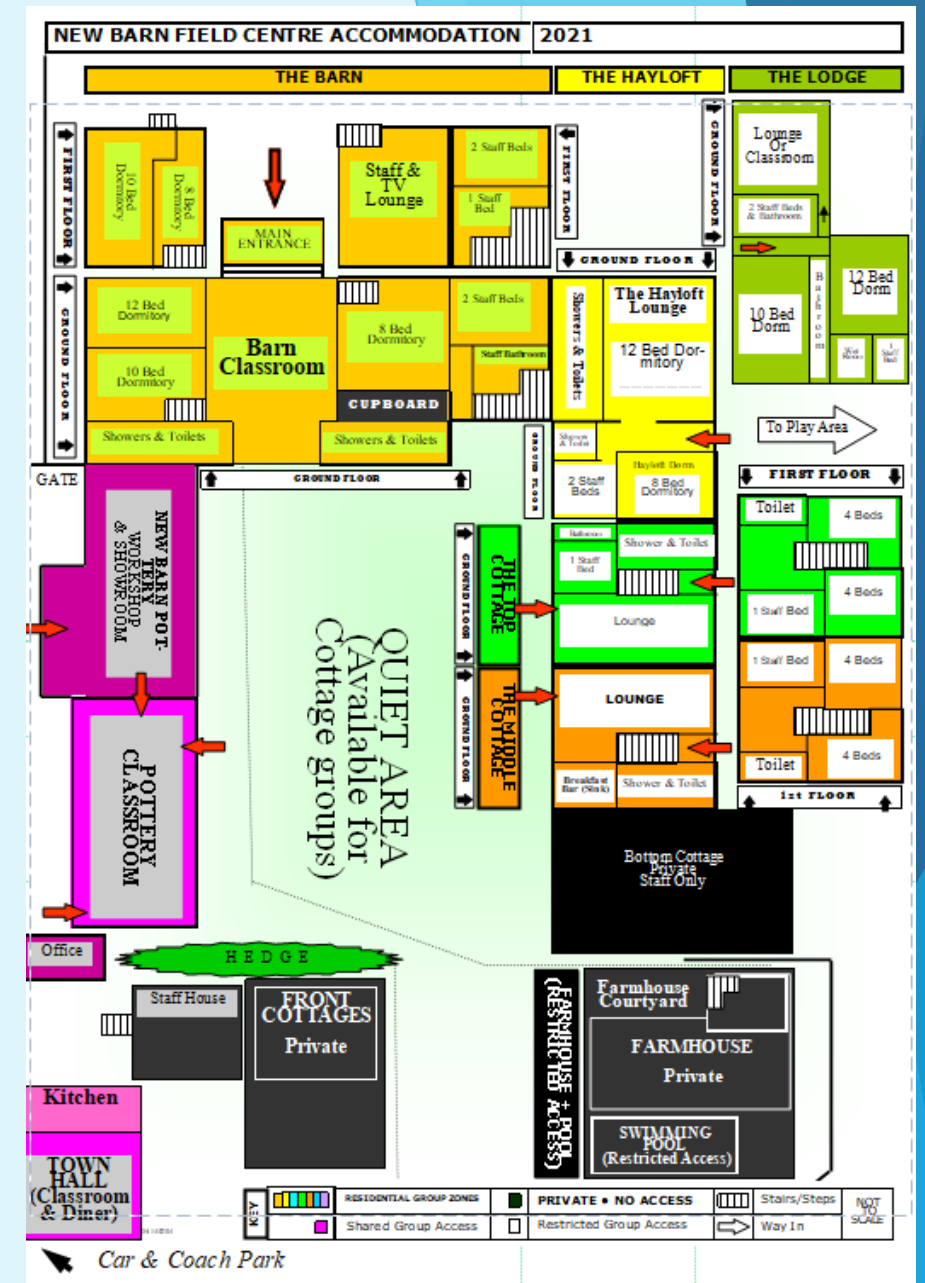
# Location

- ▶ New Barn is about an hour and a half from School. It is set on a hillside overlooking the village of Bradford Peverall, near Dorchester in Dorset
- ▶ Set in it's own 20acre nature reserve
- ▶ Family-run field centre
- ▶ 24 hour on site Ranger assistance and help
- ▶ All staff are DBS and first aid trained



# Accommodation

- ▶ Dormitory accommodation with shared bathroom facilities
- ▶ Children will be placed in single sex dorms
- ▶ We will have exclusive use of the site for the duration of our stay.



# Food

- ▶ On Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October, children will need to bring a packed lunch to school. If you are eligible for FSM, we can prepare this for you- please let your child's class teacher know if you would like this
- ▶ The rest of the meals will be provided by the centre
- ▶ Breakfast will be either continental or cooked
- ▶ Lunch is a packed lunch- children will make their sandwich choices
- ▶ Fresh, homemade dinners each night
- ▶ Children may bring some sweets for the journey and a few for the week. However, we do not want to be dealing with sick children who have over indulged. It will spoil their trip, so please do not pack vast amounts of sweets. If a child arrives with too many, they will be rationed through the week by staff.

# Key details
