Please find below important information regarding the upcoming Sports Days.

### Year R

The Year R Sports Day will run on the school field on the morning of Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June. It will commence at 9:15am and parents can access the school through the main school gate from just after 9:00am. There will be a signing in sheet that you will need to complete when you come through the gates.

The children will rotate around a number of activities and you will be able to follow the children around and cheer them on.

Please ensure the children have hats and full water bottles in school. Please apply sun cream before they come to school. Please send the children to school in their PE kits (they will be sent home with their PE kits the day before), which they can stay in all day.

### Year 1/2

The Year 1/2 Sports Day will run on the school field on the afternoon of Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June. It will commence at 1:15pm and parents can access the school through the main school gate from just after 1:00pm. There will be a signing in sheet that you will need to complete when you come through the gates.

The children will alternate in year groups between field and track activities before all undertaking the sprint races together. Parents will be able to follow the children around and cheer them on.

Please ensure the children have hats and full water bottles in school. Please apply sun cream before they come to school. Please send the children to school in their PE kits (they will be sent home with their PE kits the day before).

### Key Stage Two

The Key Stage Two Sports Day will run on the school field on the afternoon of Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June. It will commence at 12:45pm and parents can access the school through the main school gate from just after 12:30pm. There will be a signing in sheet that you will need to complete when you come through the gates.

The children will alternate in year groups between field and track activities before all undertaking the sprint races together. Parents will be able to follow the children around and cheer them on.

Please ensure the children have hats and water bottles in school. Please apply sun cream before they come to school. Please send the children to school in their PE kits (they will be sent home with their PE kits the day before).

All children should be wearing a PE kit that is appropriate to their house colour and will preferably be an official school PE top. If your child needs a top please contact me as I may be able to procure you one from the FOBs "new-to-you" stock for £1.

FOBs will be selling refreshments during the Year 1/2 and Key Stage Two Sports Days. Please remember these are for spectators until after the event when you can purchase items for your children including ice-creams. This year, FOBs will also be selling house coloured flags that you can purchase as you enter the school for younger siblings, the children who are participating and even yourself to help you cheer on your child's team! These will be 50p each and can be passed to your children to use during the event.

Just a reminder that if you are coming to any of the Sports Days the school is a no-smoking site and this include e-cigarettes. Tops must be worn at all times and if you need the toilet whilst on site you will need to speak to a member of staff who will direct you to the toilets which you can use.

Sports Day is always a highlight of the school year and we very much look forward to seeing you at these events.
