Dear Parents,

From later today, your child's report can be accessed via Arbor. The purpose of these reports is to ensure that they are 'parent friendly' and provide you easily with the key information about your child's achievement for this academic year. To this end, there is a numbered grading system used for effort and attainment. The key for this is shown below:

The expectations under the current National Curriculum for each year group remain exceptionally high and we continue to work hard with the children to support them to meet these standards. As these bandings are quite a wide assessment we may also use a minus (-) and plus (+). The minus indicates that a child is only just meeting this attainment description and a plus indicates that they are close to meeting the next attainment description.

Parents will also be able to access the outcomes of statutory assessments – Phonics for Year 1 and some Year 2 children and Multiplication check for Year 4 children. The pass mark for the phonics check was 31 out of 40. There is no pass mark for the multiplication check, which is out of 25. As you will be aware Year 6 SATS results have been delayed nationally and these will be shared with you once we have them. Please talk to your child's class teacher if you have any further queries.

Please do come along to our open classrooms on Tuesday 14th July (3:30pm - 4:00pm) to look at your child's work from over the year and to discuss the report with your child's teacher if you so wish. This will also be an opportunity to take home your children's books from this year – as such you may well wish to bring a bag to transport them home in! Some children may have less books to take home than others as they could be continuing to use them next year. If you are unable to come and collect your children's book during the open classrooms, please provide your child with a bag to bring their books home in on Friday the 17th July.

If your child's new teacher for next academic year is on site during this afternoon and is available then you are welcome to speak to them as well.

If you have any queries about reports, or the open classrooms, please do speak to your child's class teacher.
